

# **Airports & Transportation**

Conventions and meetings held in Anaheim/Orange County can bring in attendees and exhibitors from all over the world with ease through the four major airports nearby.











## John Wayne Airport (SNA)

Approximately 20 minutes from Anaheim Convention Center Approximate rates to and from Anaheim:

- **Shuttle Services:** starting at \$10 per person/one way
- Disneyland Resort Express Bus: \$17 per person/one way (\$27 round trip) •
- Taxi: metered rates, from \$45-\$75 per car or van load/one way
- Rental Car, Van or SUV: \$50-\$95 per car/day
- Limousine Service: \$115 per car/one way •
- Town Car or SUV Service: \$85 per car/one way

# Los Angeles International (LAX)

Approximately 45-60 minutes from Anaheim Convention Center

## Approximate rates to and from Anaheim:

- Shuttle Services: starting at \$16 per person/one way
- Disneyland Resort Express Bus: \$22 per person/one way (\$32 round trip)
- Taxi: metered rates, from \$90-\$130 per car or van load/one way
- Rental Car, Van or SUV: \$50-\$130 per car or van/daily •
- **Limousine Service:** \$160 per car/one way
- Town Car or SUV Service: \$100 per car/one way

# Ontario International (ONT)

Approximately 45-60 minutes from Anaheim Convention Center Approximate rates to and from Anaheim:

- Shuttle Services: \$35 for the first person + \$9-10 each additional person/one way
- **Taxi:** metered rates, from \$50-\$80 per car or van/one way •
- Rental Car, Van or SUV: \$75-\$100 per car or van/daily •
- **Limousine Service:** \$110 per car/one way
- Town Car or SUV Service: \$90 per car/one way

# Long Beach Airport (LGB)

Approximately 30-45 minutes from Anaheim Convention Center Approximate rates to and from Anaheim:

- Shuttle Services: \$43 for the first person + \$9-10 each additional person/one way
- Taxi: metered rates, from \$95-\$135 per car or van/one way
- Rental Car, Van or SUV: \$45-\$95 per car or van/daily
- **Limousine Service:** \$170 per car/one way
- Town Car or SUV Service: \$110 per car/one way







# **Airports & Transportation**

Located in the center of Southern California, Anaheim/Orange County is very accessible. With public transportation and a variety of ground transportation, there are plenty of resources to help you get to and travel around Anaheim/Orange County.



### Anaheim Resort Transit (ART)

The ART is the transportation system of Anaheim and the greater Anaheim Resort® District, including the cities of Anaheim, Garden Grove and Orange. ART's frequent service with 17 routes allows for easy access and convenient connections. One, three and five day passes available for adults and children (pricing \$1-16).



### **Orange County Transit Authority (OCTA) Bus**

OCTA operates the public bus system in Orange County. With approximately 77 bus routes covering 6,200 bus stops, it connects the entire Orange County region. One day passes are \$4.



### Amtrak

Amtrak, a nationwide rail service, provides convenient passenger rail service within the Orange County area. Amtrak's 11 trains serve Anaheim, Fullerton, Irvine, Santa Ana and San Juan Capistrano on a daily basis.



### Metrolink

Metrolink is Southern California's rail system and provides meeting and convention attendees easy access to major points of interest. The Orange County portion of the Metrolink has 11 stations offering 42 round trip schedules every weekday on three lines.



### Anaheim Regional Transportation Intermodal Center (ARTIC)

ARTIC will serve as the central hub for all transportation modes; a place where freeways, bus routes, and rail transit systems will converge in the heart of Anaheim. In the future, ARTIC will also accommodate the Anaheim Rapid Connection (ARC) and high-speed trains. *Estimated completion of ARTIC is 2014.*
