



SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA TOURS ATTRACTIONS

Desert Cities:

Anza Borrego and Palm Springs are just a drive away. Famous for the warm weather, golf and resorts. In the spring, look for the blooming of the desert wild flowers.

Disneyland and

California Adventure Park:

Located just two hours from the hotel, this wonderland has been famous for decades.

Knotts Berry Farm:

Originally just that, a berry farm, now famous for its rollercoaster rides, ghost town, music and fun. Located in Buena Park, about two hours from the hotel.

Mission San Luis Rey and

Mission San Juan Capistrano:

Located in the Long Beach Harbor, the Queen Mary is the famous luxury liner that once transported famous dignitaries and celebrities to Europe.

Balloon Tours:

City Tours:
